The Holmberg Scholarship Fund

Dr. Richard Bryson and daughter Mary Bryson Dentler Scholarship

The Hempfield Foundation (HF) was established in November 1993 after interested Hempfield residents met to discuss ways to enhance the educational opportunities of public school students. Through their efforts, the HF became a reality and today is a private, nonprofit, charitable organization with a growing board drawn from the residents of the Hempfield School District. The HF raises funds through tax-deductible contributions, endowments and fund raisers, to promote, enhance, and supplement educational programs of the Hempfield School District.

HF is proud to continue the Holmberg Scholarship Fund and the Dr. Richard Bryson and daughter, Mary Bryson Dentler Scholarship, both of which are a one-time scholarship valued at \$3000.

The Holmberg Scholarship Fund was established in 1998 by Mrs. Barbara Holmberg Eichmann, a current and long-time Hempfield resident. Richard Holmberg, her deceased husband, had been a successful business owner, and many of their children and grandchildren are Hempfield graduates. Mrs. Holmberg and her family recognize the value of a good education, the need and desire to continue learning, and that learning is a life-long endeavor.

The Dr. Richard Bryson and daughter, Mary Bryson Dentler Scholarship is awarded in memory of Dr. Bryson, a long time Landisville physician and Hempfield School physician and Mary Bryson Dentler, a 1980 Hempfield High School graduate. A native of Landisville, Mary graduated from Indiana University of PA with a business degree. A dedicated wife and mother to two children, she worked several years in banking. Mary passed away in October 2001.

A recipient of either scholarship must be : (1) an undergraduate at a college or university who is pursuing studies to meet the requirements for an academic or professional degree; or (2) a full-time or part-time student at an educational organization that provides an educational program of training to prepare students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation; and is authorized under federal or state law to provide such a program, and is accredited by a nationally recognized accreditation agency. As stipulated in the Mary Bryson Dentler Scholarship, preference will be given to applicants who seek to continue their education at Indiana University of PA.

Either scholarship can be used only for tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance of a student at an educational organization, as defined below, and for fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses of instruction at such an educational organization.
