The Lancaster Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders (AAPI) Scholarship

About this scholarship: The Hempfield Foundation was established in November 1993 after interested Hempfield residents met to discuss ways to enhance the educational opportunities of public school students. The Foundation raises funds through tax-deductible contributions, endowments, and fund raisers, to promote, enhance, and supplement educational programs of the Hempfield School District. A key part of this mission is to provide scholarships to graduating seniors.

Lancaster Asian Americans Pacific Islanders (AAPI) began with a group of Asian Americans searching for a larger community and an opportunity to amplify individual voices, allow people to connect, and to celebrate AAPI contributions to the rich history of Lancaster County. The organization includes dedicated community members who are working on advocacy, development, events, marketing, communications, and more.

One Lancaster AAPI Scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded annually by the Foundation as funding is available. This is a one-time scholarship that will be awarded to a student who identifies with a member state of the Asia-Pacific regional group of member states defined by the United Nations (a list of the member states of the Asia-Pacific regional group is attached)

Annual Scholarship Amount to be awarded: \$1,000

Key Scholarship Requirements:

- A recipient of this scholarship must be enrolling as full or part-time student at a
 postsecondary educational institution to pursue an academic or professional degree,
- The postsecondary educational institution being attended by the recipient must provide an educational program of training that prepares students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation, is authorized under federal or state law to provide such a program, and is accredited by a nationally recognized accreditation organization,
- The applicant must identify with a member state of the Asia-Pacific regional group of member states as defined by the United Nations,
- Consideration of financial need (as indicated by their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)/EFC#) will be taken into account.

Use of the Scholarship: The scholarship may be used for tuition/credit fees, books/materials, computers/technology, room and board or any other costs directly related to the recipient's course of study.
