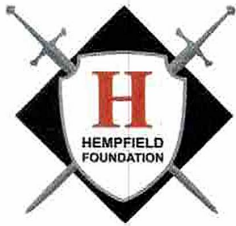

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The George Rakoczy Memorial Scholarship for Graduating Entrepreneurs

Scholarship Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to honor the memory of George Rakoczy by providing financial support to a graduating Hempfield student with an entrepreneurial spirit who is pursuing postsecondary education or training other than a four-year college degree.

About George Rakoczy: George Rakoczy was an owner and CEO of Warfel Construction in Lancaster.

Despite being born in communist Hungary, George never allowed the communist perspective to quash his entrepreneurial spirit. In 1956, during the Hungarian Uprising, he bravely fled his homeland to begin a new life in the United States. He got his first job in construction after serving in the United States Army and while studying civil engineering. George was incredibly appreciative of the freedoms and opportunities found in this country, and he was always determined to succeed. George passed away in 1995.

Annual Scholarship Amount to be awarded: \$5,000

Key Recipient Criteria: The scholarship shall be awarded to a graduating Hempfield High School senior pursuing postsecondary education or training other than a four-year college degree. Consideration of financial need (as indicated by their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)/EFC#) will be taken into account. In addition, the recipient must:

- Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average
- Have a strong portfolio of elective classes taught by the Technology and Engineering and/or Business, Computer and Information Technology Departments

- Demonstrate an entrepreneurial spirit through a short written essay (500 words or less) or video (two minutes or less)

The Timothy David Nolt Memorial Scholarship Award

The Timothy David Nolt Memorial Scholarship Award will be presented annually in the spring to a male Hempfield High School student-athlete, who has achieved a minimum of a 3.25 scholastic grade point average, and who has participated on the varsity soccer team. The award recipient must have demonstrated good sportsmanship, character, and leadership, and must have shown academic strength in the fields of math, science, technology. He should have an educational goal of attending college.

This award is given as a memorial to Timothy Nolt, an outstanding graduate of Hempfield's Class of 1987, who passed away in April of 2011. While in Hempfield schools, he participated in soccer programs from elementary grades through his senior year. He demonstrated academic and athletic excellence throughout his educational and professional career. An ambitious student, Tim earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from Lehigh University and a Master's in Business Finance from the University of Connecticut. As a parent, Tim continued to demonstrate his love and expertise in soccer by coaching the Youth program in Hebron, Connecticut. Throughout his life he possessed integrity, loyalty, and a strong work ethic. At the time of his death, he was serving in an executive managerial position at UTC-Pratt & Whitney Corporation, East Hartford, Connecticut.

Applicants will be judged by a representative of the Hempfield faculty and members of the Nolt family. The award will be presented through the Hempfield Foundation at the annual Hempfield High School Commencement Awards Ceremony. A bronze plaque honoring the memory of Tim was placed on the Alumni Wall of the Hempfield High School Alumni Plaza during the spring of 2012. In addition, the name of the recipient will be placed on a plaque of honorees for this award in the school's athletic office.

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The Fritz Family Scholarship in Honor of Elizabeth (Fritz) Erb

About this scholarship: The Hempfield Foundation was established in November 1993 to enhance the educational opportunities of public school students. The Foundation raises funds through tax-deductible contributions, endowments, and fund raisers, to promote, enhance, and supplement educational programs of the Hempfield School District. A key part of this mission is to provide scholarships to graduating seniors.

Elizabeth (Fritz) Erb was a player on the very first Hempfield girls lacrosse team, and she led her squad to consecutive league titles in 2001 and 2002—the 2001 championship being the first one ever awarded for the sport in Lancaster County. She became an assistant coach for the Lady Knights in 2003, and in 2006, Liz became the head coach of the Hempfield team. While coaching, Liz graduated from Millersville University Summa Cum Laude in 3.5 years with a BA in Elementary & Early Childhood Education followed later by a Masters in Instructional Technology from Wilkes University. In 2019, after 13 years of coaching Hempfield girls lacrosse, she retired as the all-time winningest lacrosse coach in Lancaster-Lebanon League history. While she helped her players sharpen their game skills, Liz was even more focused on making sure her players developed all the intangible qualities that build strong character and lead to success off the playing field. Her positive impact on Hempfield students continues in her role as a fifth grade teacher at Farmdale Elementary School.

The Fritz Family Scholarship is awarded to a graduating member of the Hempfield girls lacrosse team who is passionate and driven as an athlete, who demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship and exemplary character, and who excels as a student. Up to two Elizabeth Erb Scholarship of \$800 each may be awarded annually by the Foundation.
